WHO IS EN VIE

En Vie Performance Company (En Vie) is Mississippi Ballet Theatre's (MBT) Performance and Competition team. Students involved in En Vie take class at least 2 times per week and study many areas of dance including ballet, jazz, hip-hop, tap, lyrical, and ethnic dance.

En Vie dancers will perform or compete at the following events: MS State Fair's got Talent, Christmas Recital, two or more competitions in the spring/summer, and both yearend recitals. En Vie dancers may be asked to appear or perform at other events such as MBT Night with the M-Braves, the warm up for the Making Strides Against Breast Cancer Walk and at local Nursing Homes and other community events.

We are so happy that you decided to audition for MBT's En Vie Performance Company. We want to make sure that everyone is aware of the commitment it takes to be a part of a group like this. Your teammates count on you and your participation in **ALL** practices and events. Every dancer is affected by your attendance, your attitude, and your level of commitment.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

The financial commitment for En Vie can add up. It's recommended that you break this up monthly so that it is not a shock to your budget come competition season. You may add \$X amount per a month to your regular tuition to start preparing for competition season.

MONTHLY PARENTS MEETINGS

En Vie parents are required to attend a monthly meeting the first Thursday of every month. If you have items that need to be added to the agenda, please send those to laurie.a.campbell@hotmail.com or text 601 – 862 – 8528 by the Friday before the meeting. The meeting agenda will be emailed Monday evening to ensure a smooth and productive meeting.

All En Vie Parents will meet at 6:00 p.m.

SATURDAY REHEARSALS

En Vie will have some Saturday rehearsals to learn choreography. There will be a choreography fee for these extra rehearsals.

ATTENDANCE

Dancers are required to attend all rehearsals and performances. Dancers will not be permitted to enter class late. Dancers need to arrive at the studio prepared for class or with plenty of time to change be in the studio for the start of class.

Please do your best not to be late or to miss rehearsal. You will only be allowed two excused absences for illness, death in the family, or a family trip.

- You must bring in a doctor's excuse if you are sick.
- You may not miss more than one of your regular dances classes per month.
- You must clear a planned family trip two months in advance.

If you have an unexcused absence from a practice or choreography session you will have to make it up at the cost of a private lesson (usually about \$50 per hour).

**Poor attendance will result in your dismissal from En Vie
and forfeiture of all fees and costumes.**

ATTITUDE AND WORK ETHIC

Dancers:

- Your attitude is everything! Please maintain a positive attitude at all times. Be each other's cheerleader! Please watch what you post on public websites such as Facebook. If you have a question or problem please come see Ms. Allison. She will have some regular office hours in the mornings this year. If you post negative information about En Vie or Mississippi Ballet Theatre or any of its teachers or dancers, you will be dismissed from company.
- You must have a strong work ethic. When you are in rehearsal, you are there to dance. NO complaining, horseplay, or cell phones allowed. Please be "on task" at all times. Dancers may only bring bottled water to rehearsal.

- Please respect your teachers and fellow dancers. Set a good example for the other students at MBT. You are the BEST OF THE BEST!

Parents:

- Please maintain a positive attitude regarding practices, competitions, MBT, and other dance studios. Please watch what you post on public websites such as Facebook. If you have a question or problem please come see Ms. Allison. She will have regular office hours in the mornings this year. If you post negative information about En Vie or Mississippi Ballet Theatre or any of its teachers or dancers, your dancer will be dismissed from company.
- Encourage your dancers to maintain their commitment. If you don't care if they make it to practice, then why would they care. It's your money and you should get the best for your money!
- Be a member of the En Vie Booster Club and participate in as many events as you can!

FUNDRAISING

All fundraising money earned will go toward group events and competition numbers. If appropriate funds are available, they will be assigned using an allowance provided for each dancer. For example, \$X toward hotel for Disney trip or competition fees paid for the group number. A family with one dancer would receive one allowance; a family with two dancers would receive two allowances, and so on.

En Vie parents host the Recitals – we share responsibility in set up, production and clean up.

En Vie parents are required to be backstage to assist their dancer with costume changes. This could be anywhere from 4 to 8 or more changes. In addition to ensuring your dancer is ready for their next number, En Vie parents will be assigned a certain number of songs to act as the stage manager.

Stage manager responsibilities include:

- dancers are lined up and ready to go on stage
- props are ready and placed for dance number
- there should always be one dance on stage, one dance lined up and ready with props off stage, and one dance in the hall ready to move forward

Stage manager responsibilities will be assigned in pairs and based on when you are free from assisting or watching your dancer. No parent should miss their child's dance. It's important we work as a **TEAM** to ensure this. 😊
