Clip On Bun – several parents opt for the clip on to save time and stress during quick costume changes at competitions.

Cost ??? at the Hair Supply Store in Clinton

Hair Net is a must to save time and spray gel.

Cost \$1.00 – 2.00 for two at Sally's Beauty Supply

1. Place over bun and secure with bobby pins.



Mesh (This is my favorite) - better for short to medium length hair

Cost \$3.00 – \$4.00 at Sally's Beauty Supply

1. Place hair in a pony tail.
2. Slide mesh over pony tail.
3. Have child look down, let hair from pony tail fall over mesh (and cover it completely).
4. Secure with pony tail holder.
5. Bobby pin extra hair and cover with a hair net.



Magic Bun – better for long hair

Cost ??? at Jazzy Dancer

1. Place hair in pony tail.
2. Place pony tail thru Magic Bun and slide to almost the end of the pony tail.
3. Roll hair up (around the Magic Bun).
4. Secure ends of Magic Bun.
5. Bobby pin bun in place and cover with a hair net.
